Please see attached information for the AGN Track & Field Leagues of 9 & 12 December 2020. No primary school learners are allowed to participate at these leagues.

Athletes competing at the league need to complete the following before entering the stadium:

- AGN Indemnity form
- AGN/TUKS Covid-19 App/form before entering the stadium
- Entry form, using the google link
- Paid R30-00 participation fee
- Have an ASA License number or purchases an AGN temporary number

We are limited to 500 persons at a time in the stadium and this includes AGN officials, office, stadium staff, coaches & athletes.

Spectators at the event

No spectators will be allowed at the event during Lockdown Level 1.

Take note of the following;

- Parents/persons bringing athletes to the stadium will **NOW** only be allowed to be in the parking area, all other areas are prohibited areas.
- Parents/persons bringing athletes to the stadium have a choice of either waiting in the parking area, or to come back and fetch athletes.
- No persons will be allowed at the road where the long jump is situated or any other area.

Clubs please note that you have a very important role to play and need to adhere to this at all times.

We thank the clubs(schools) who adhere to all the rules and regulations.

Rules & regulations

ASA & World Athletics rules to be followed as well as COVID 19 rules, guidelines & Government Regulations as well as the stadium requirements for each athletics event.

COVID rules, guidelines & regulations

The following procedures will take place at the entrance

- Athletes need to report to the call room 30 minutes prior to their event
- No mask no entry
- Washing of hands/santizing hands at all events partaking in and entrance of the Stadium as well as bathrooms
- A screening area will be situated at the entrance to the Stadium where all protocols as per Government Regulations and ASA requirements will be met including taking of temperatures/completing health questionnaire before entering the Stadium
- If the temperature of a coach/athlete is higher than 38 degrees, he/she will be isolated along with anyone in a venue/facility designated for this purpose, that is with him/her. Temperature/s will be retaken after a reasonable time and if the temperature of the individual/s remains **above 37.4 degrees**, he/she and everyone with such an individual, **will not be allowed entrance to the Stadium**
- Athletes younger than 18, will not be allowed without receiving indemnity form from the parent and must be completed on Google forms the day prior to the event
- **Only athletes with permanent ASA (Athletics South Africa) license numbers will be allowed to enter the stadium, if athletes do not have numbers, they can purchase this at the AGN office prior to the event, this must be done in advance as No entries will be accepted without ASA License numbers.**
- Only coaches who are accredited with Athletics South Africa/AGN will be allowed to enter the stadium only when their athlete/s participate. Coaches must provide proof of such registration at the screening area.
- As soon as the event of the athlete in question is completed, the coach and athlete must please vacate the Stadium to allow other athletes and coaches to enter to keep the total numbers of people in the Stadium below 500.
- Athletes and coaches can only enter the stadium on the time the athlete received prior to the event.

- No athletes will be allowed to enter on the day of the event
- No spectators will be allowed at the event
- Isolation room will be available

Please see attached ASA Circular 48, Health & Safety Protocols, Guidelines for entering a stadium, this must be adhered to at all times
