CIRCULAR 08 OF 2023 –UNSANCTIONED (UNLAWFUL) RACES

Dear AGN Members,

The AGN Board and AGN Council have approved the 2023 AGN Provincial Fixtures list and based on discussions that took place at a number of AGN Annual Meetings that took place in 2022, all members are reminded that all athletics events must be sanctioned by Athletics Gauteng North as the custodian of athletics within the province. All sanctioned events will appear on the AGN fixtures list or will be communicated to all members through the AGN Office.

We have noticed that there are unsanctioned events, especially road races/runs taking place within AGN, which members are not covered by the athlete's insurance and are damagingly impacting the value of road races who followed the correct processes in order to be sanctioned.

AGN would therefore like to remind members of Clause 7.2 of the AGN Constitution: *“Any affiliated club, or committee, or any office-bearer or licensed athlete of any affiliated club or committee who disregards or disobeys any rule, by-law or regulation made by AGN, or by one of its commissions or committees, or by ASA, or who conducts himself/herself in such a way as to injure the interests of athletes or athletics, or to bring athletics into disrepute, shall be guilty of misconduct and subject to the discipline of AGN”*

Let us collectively work towards a common goal in 2023 with reviving sanctioning road races as one of our ultimate objectives.
