Dear AGN Members,

Athletics Gauteng North sincerely apologises to all members, athletes, parents, and coaches for the disruptions experienced during League 3 on Saturday, 21 February 2026. We especially regret the issues that affected the 100m events, where some athletes were unable to compete as scheduled.

Your patience and understanding during this time are greatly appreciated and we have worked closely with the AGN Track & Field Commission to put corrective measures in place to ensure fairness and smoother event management going forward.

Athletes who were affected in the 100m events will be allowed to enter and participate in the AGN League 4 on Saturday, 28 February 2026. These specific athletes as well as their parents accompanying them, will not be required to pay entrance or participation fees, provided the parents are accompanying their children.
