CIRCULAR 27 OF 2025 – AGN 1 Mile (1.6KM) CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

Dear AGN Members,

Athletics Gauteng North (AGN) will be hosting the Provincial 1 Mile (1.6km) Championships on Saturday, 11 April 2025 incorporated with the Green Mile Road Race at the Sports Park Sports Venue, Corner of Sports Road and Kruger Avenue, Lyttelton Manor (Green Mile Club House).

All athletes will be required to participate with an ASA 2026 permanent license number or purchase a temporary license number at the venue for R70.00 per license. Athletes may not run with another athlete's permanent license.

Please note that the AGN 1 Mile Championships is compulsory in order to be selected onto the AGN 1 Mile Team that will be participating at the ASA AGN 1 Mile Championships on Saturday, 27 June 2026 in Gqeberha – kindly find the selection criteria attached.

Age tags – Masters and Junior Athletes

All master and junior athletes must run with an age tag. Clearly displayed, one in front of the running vest and one on the back of the running vest. Age tags will be available for purchase at the event for R30.00 a pair.
