RULES: The Race is run in accordance with the rules of ASA and AGN

1. Athletes who do not adhere to the rules will be disqualified.
2. Registered athletes must wear the 2026 license number. Race numbers must be worn on the front and must not cover the ASA and sponsors logos.
3. All licensed athletes competing for category prizes must wear numeric category tags, clearly visible on the front and back of their vests. Proof of age for prize winners may be required to be presented to referees before receiving the prize. Prizes will be withheld until confirmed. Race Numbers must not cover the logos on the license.
4. Walkers competing for prize money must wear WALKER/W tags on the front and back of their vests.
5. Minimum age for race entries: 5km: 9 Years 10km: 14 Years | 21.1km: 16 Years
6. No seconding is allowed.
7. **Temporary licensed Athletes are eligible** for open and category prizes, provided they have the age category tag clearly visible on the front and back of their vests.
8. All traffic officers and official instructions to be obeyed.
- 9 Time limit is 3 hours, 30 minutes, for ALL athletes. Last runner/walker must finish by 09h30.
10. No blade, cyclist, or mechanically operated device allowed in the race.
11. All athletes participate solely at their own risk and the organisers and sponsors will not be held responsible for any injury, illness, accidents or theft occurring during, or as a result of the race.
12. International Foreign Athletes must purchase a temporary License Number and must produce clearance from their member federation if are contenders for Prizes.

Late entries can be made from Wednesday, 11 March 2026 until before the race on Saturday, 14 March 2026 at the Vodashop at Irene Village Mall.

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Entries can be collected at the Vodashop from Wednesday, 11 - 13 March 2026 15h00 - 18h00, or on Saturday before the race from 04h30 - 06h00.
