Pre-entered athletes will receive a race card with a barcode via email or WhatsApp. Please print and bring it along. Plastic sleeves and pins will be provided at the start. Pre-entry helps avoid long queues on race day.

On-the-day entries will be available at the venue. Entry fees are R50 per athlete and R20 for spectators. Athletes entering on the day will receive a blank race card to complete.

All athletes must compete with a valid ASA 2026 permanent license or purchase a temporary license at the venue (R70). Junior, Senior, and Master athletes must wear age-category tags. No athlete will be allowed to compete without a valid license number.

COACHES ENTRY

Please note that only registered AGN/ASA coaches will be allowed to enter the stadium and only if their athletes are participating. Please bring your coach's card with you.
