Dear AGN Members

Athletics Gauteng North hosted the biggest League, AGN Cross Country League 2, to date with 1730 participants. AGN would like to thank the Cross Country Community for your support and thank Manie Groenewald and Green Mile AC for a successful League 2. Kindly find the results attached.

The third AGN Cross Country League 3 (all ages) will take place at **SUTHERLAND HIGH SCHOOL**, hosted by AGN and Worth It AC on Saturday, 23 May 2026.

Athletes and coaches are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the AGN Cross Country Selection Criteria for 2026. This document contains important updates and guidelines relevant to the season.

ATHLETES ENTRIES – 23 May 2026

Race Tag Sheet

Dear Name,
You can use the same barcoded race tag for all pre-season cross-country leagues.

Print instructions:

- Print this document on A4 paper.
- Cut out the rectangular race tag (approximately 7.0 x 3.5 cm).

At the event:

- Bring your race tag with you.
- Place it inside a plastic sheath and pin it to your clothes. Plastic sheaths and pins will be provided.

How entries work:

- This race tag is valid for every pre-season league.
- Do not have to enter separately for each league on Crossland.

Payment:

- You must still pay for each league on Webtickets.
- Race Tags (Crossland) and payment (Webtickets) are separate steps.

Important: Use only this race tag during the race.

- Any other barcode or ticket is only for venue access and proof of payment.

If you lose your race tag:

- Go to crossland.co.za/athlete/new and enter again. This same race tag sheet will be sent to you.
- You can also download your race tag sheet from your athlete page on crossland.co.za/athlete/1766.



The closing date for pre-entries is 22 May 2026 at 18:00.

In an effort to provide faster and more efficient registration for the AGN Pre-Season Cross Country League meetings, all athletes are requested to complete the online race tag application once <https://crossland.co.za/athlete/new>.

After completing the form, athletes will receive a personalised barcode race tag via email or WhatsApp (if you do not have an email), similar to the example on the left. This same race tag can then be used for all AGN pre-season leagues, eliminating the need to register again for each league meeting.

Athletes are required to print and bring their race tag to every AGN League. Please note that race tag registration and event entry fees are separate processes and athletes will still need to pay their entry fees for each league via Webtickets.

All athletes must compete with a valid ASA 2026 permanent license or purchase a temporary license at the venue (R70). Junior, Senior, and Master athletes must wear age-category tags. No athlete will be allowed to compete without a valid license number.

COACHES ENTRY

Please note that only registered AGN/ASA coaches will be allowed to enter the stadium and only if their athletes are participating. Please bring your coaches card with you.

Coaches not affiliated with AGN/ASA will be required to pay spectator admission fees.
