RACE RULES AND INFORMATION

- The race is held in line with rules of Athletics South Africa ("ASA") and Athletics Gauteng North ("AGN").
- International athletes competing must adhere to WA Rules (WA Rule 4.2).
- Athletes should participate with the provided race bib (to wear in front) and the 2 (two) ASA 2026 Permanent License number (back & front) or the Temporary number at the back.
- Race number must be visible at all times and worn on the front of the upper outer garment.
- Non-registered athletes in the 10km are required to purchase a temporary licence in addition to the race entry fee and this number must be worn at the back of their vest.
- International Foreign Athletes MUST purchase a temporary License Number and must produce clearance from their member federation if are contenders for Prizes.
- The Prize money offered will be paid in cash at the race as per advertised Prize Money.
- Athletes in the age category prize will be requested to produce proof of identity before awarded prize money.
- Any athletes who cannot on request produce acceptable proof of age documents will be afforded three days in which to comply, failing which he/she will not qualify for any age group prize.
- Category Age Athletes (juniors and Masters) must wear their age categories tags.
- All age categories from 40+ will compete for one Prize Money as stipulated in the Prize money schedule.
- Medals will be awarded to ALL finishers.
- No athletes under the age of 14 years will be allowed to run the 10 km race.
- Athletes under the age of 9 years will be allowed to participate in the 5km, provided that their parent/guardian accompanies them at all times.
- Marshalls, traffic, police, and all race officials must be obeyed at all times.
- For safety reasons, the use of personal music players with earphones or headphones is not allowed. Any person using such device in contravention of WA TR6.3 or ASA Rule 34.10 shall not be eligible for individual or team prizes and may be disqualified.
- Entry fees are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- Vendors (goods / services) may apply for a stall space at a fee to soshanguvegreastrunnersac@gmail.com.
- Pro-Timing will be used for electronic results.
- The athlete grants their permission, in terms of Section 51 of the Electronic Communications Transactions Act 25 of 2002, to Soshanguve Great Runners AC to use their name, race information, and photographs, video tapes, broadcasts and telecasts in which they may appear free of charge. Soshanguve Great Runners AC are compliant with the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (POPIA) and is committed to storing, using, and processing participant data in a manner compliant with the guidelines prescribed by POPIA.
- Participants accepts that their personal information will remain confidential and hereby consent to same being shared with the parties involved in the organisation of the event for purposes of results, medical care, and/or promotion of activities related to the event.
- Tog Bag Area will be allocated adjacent to the finish.
- Club Gazebos are allowed and may be erected from 05h00 on the day of the race. Race organizers will demarcate an area for all clubs who would like to erect gazebos.
