- Late Entries will be taken on Race Day 9 September, from 15:00 until 18:20.
- Water points located approximately every 3km with coke, water and entertainment.
- Cut-off time is 2 hours.
- The Race Route is NOT wheelchair friendly.
- Refreshments will be available on sale.
- No gas braaiing permitted.
- No unauthorised selling of goods will be allowed on the university grounds.
- Race results will be available on the internet at www.results.finitime.co.za
- Tog bag facilities: Club tents will be erected Wednesday, 9 September from 15:00 - 17:00 at designated areas.
- Walkers must wear their "W" tags to be eligible for the prize.
- Distance markers at every 1km.
- Medals to all finishers.

Race Rules

- The race will take place under the rules of ASA, AGN and WA
- All participants must wear two valid 2026 License numbers (front and back) or a temporary license for the 10km race. No License needed for the 5km Fun Run
- Race numbers should not cover the valid ASA license logos.
- All athletes participate at their own risk and by their entry, they indemnify the organisers, province and sponsors of any liability or claims.
- Marshals and traffic officials must be obeyed at all times.
- No seconding will be permitted.
- Proof of age may be requested from category winners.
- Minimum age on race day is 14 years for the 10km
- Junior category winners must provide proof of age to qualify for prizes (ID or other valid documentation).
- Ambulance services and medical personnel will be on standby during the race.
- Age category identification tags to be worn on the front and back of the running/walking vest to be eligible for prizes.
- No iPods or listening devices allowed.
- International Foreign Athletes must purchase a temporary License Number and must produce clearance from their member federation if are contenders for Prizes
