CIRCULAR 64 OF AGN 2026 – AGN CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS, 15 August 2026

Dear AGN Members

Athletics Gauteng North is pleased to invite all affiliated clubs, schools, coaches and athletes to participate in the 2026 AGN Cross Country Championships which will take place on Saturday, 15 August 2026 at Curro Hazeldean High School.

The Championships are open to Athletics Gauteng North athletes only and will determine the 2026 Provincial Champions in the various age categories. Athletes, coaches and team managers are requested to familiarise themselves with the attached Championships Team Manual, which contains the full programme, race schedule and all competition information.

ATHLETES ENTRIES

All entries, including club entries and individual athletes, must be submitted via Crossland by registering at: <https://crossland.co.za>

Upon successful registration via Crossland, athletes will receive their personalised Race Tag via e-mail or WhatsApp. Athletes are responsible for downloading and printing their own Race Tag before arriving at the Championships.

Race Tag Sheet

Dear Name,
You can use the same barcoded race tag for all pre-season cross-country leagues.
Print instructions:
• Print this document on A4 paper.
• Cut out the rectangular race tag (approximately 7.0 x 3.5 cm).
At the event:
• Bring your race tag with you.
• Place it inside a plastic sheath and pin it to your clothes. Plastic sheaths and pins will be provided.
How entries work:
• This race tag is valid for every pre-season league.
• Do not have to enter separately for each league on Crossland.
Payment:
• You must still pay for each league on Webtickets.
• Race Tags (Crossland) and payment (Webtickets) are separate steps.
Important: Use only this race tag during the race.
• Any other barcode or ticket is only for venue access and proof of payment.
If you lose your race tag:
• Go to crossland.co.za/athletes/new and enter again. This same race tag sheet will be sent to you.
• You can also download your race tag sheet from your athlete page on crossland.co.za/athletes/1705.



The same Race Tag used during the AGN Cross Country League meetings will be used for the Championships.

Athletes who participated in the Schools Cross Country League are already registered on Crossland and only need to download and print their Race Tag from the e-mail or WhatsApp received after registration, or access it via Crossland.

Please note:

- A valid ASA 2026 licence and South African ID number are compulsory.
- Masters (35 years and older) and Under 20 (Juniors – born in 2007 and 2008) athletes must wear the applicable age category tags.
- Temporary licences (R70) and age category tags (R30) will be available at the venue.
- All entries must be submitted via Crossland before the Championships.

COACHES ENTRY

Please note that only registered AGN/ASA coaches will be allowed to enter the venue and only if their athletes are participating. Please bring your coaches card with you.

Coaches not affiliated with AGN/ASA will be required to pay spectator admission fees.

RESULTS & APPEALS

Results will be available approximately 10 minutes after the completion of each race and will be published on the Crossland platform.

Appeals must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the publication of the results and must be accompanied by an appeal fee of R500.00.
